In the Year of Adventure



Essay Competition is open to children ages 8-12 years with the Trinidad and Tobago winner eligible to an **ALL EXPENSES PAID TRIP** for them and a Parental Chaperone to attend and participate in special activities at a major Caribbean Tourism Organization (CTO) Conference in 2017.

The competition is divided into a Formal Writing Stream and a Creative Writing Stream for two (2) age categories – 8 to 10 years and 10-12 years.

ESSAY TOPICS

In keeping with the CTO declaring 2017 as the Year of Adventure, the essay topics are in the areas of sustainable tourism, adventure tourism, ecotourism. Comprehensive information on the essay topics are available on the Ministry's website.

GUIDELINES

- Entries must be **HAND WRITTEN** and **DOUBLE SPACED**.
- Entries in the 8-10 year category must be at least 250 words in length, while entries in the 10-12 year category must be at least 350 words in length. No entry should exceed 500 words.
- The Formal Writing Stream must only include works that count as either essays or prose, while the Creative Writing Stream will only include works that count as poems or short stories.

DEADLINE

Deadline for receipt of essays is May 10, 2017.
