TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO RECEIVES 9,000 DOSES OF WHO APPROVED ASTRAZENECA COVID-19 VACCINES FROM BERMUDA

PORT OF SPAIN: 24TH MAY, 2021

Senator the Honorable Dr. Amery Browne, Minister of Foreign and CARICOM Affairs, received 9,000 World Health Organization (WHO) approved AstraZeneca COVID-19 vaccines from Bermuda today, 24th May, 2021. These vaccines were generously donated to the Government of Trinidad and Tobago by the Government of Bermuda from their existing allocation of vaccines.

The vaccines arrived at the Piarco International Airport this afternoon arrived at 4:23 p.m. and were immediately handed over to the technical team of the Ministry of Health. Minister Browne was accompanied by Her Excellency Frances Seignoret, Ambassador of Trinidad and Tobago to CARICOM and Ms. Anesa Doodnath-Siboo Principal Pharmacist (Ag.), Ministry of Health.
