TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO RECEIVES DONATION OF TWO

VENTILATORS FROM THE MEXICAN AGENCY FOR

INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION FOR DEVELOPMENT

Senator the Honourable Dr. Amery Browne, Minister of Foreign and CARICOM Affairs was on hand

at Piarco International Airport earlier today to receive two ventilators donated to Trinidad and Tobago

by the Mexican Agency for International Cooperation for Development (AMEXCID), Secretariat of

Foreign Affairs of Mexico.

Dr. Laura Elena Carillo Cubillas, Executive Director, along with other representatives from

AMEXCID and Brigadier General D.E.M. Manuel Alejandro Velazco Villanueva of the Mexican

Defence Force are leading a team from Mexico which is delivering much needed COVID-19 support

to various countries in the region, including Trinidad and Tobago. This is the second pair of

ventilators received from Mexico this year.

On behalf of the Government of Trinidad and Tobago, Minister Browne conveyed sincere

appreciation for the ventilators and for Mexico's other support rendered to us during the pandemic

by way of exchange of information and technical expertise. Minister Browne stated that such

cooperation is testament to the long-standing, friendly and collaborative ties between Trinidad and

Tobago and Mexico.

Minister Browne made particular reference to the open communication and excellent working

relationship established between the Ministry of Foreign and CARICOM Affairs and the Ambassador

of Mexico to Trinidad and Tobago, Her Excellency Rosario Asela Molinero Molinero, and expressed
